POLYCYCL - PRIVACY POLICY

Polycycl Private Limited ("Company") operates the website www.polycycl.com, which provides information about the Company's work, initiatives and updates. In this Policy, we refer to this as our "Platform." We may also communicate through newsletters or broadcast text messages for informational purposes (collectively "Services")

We are committed to respecting your privacy when you visit our website or use our Services and being transparent about how we use the information you have entrusted to us.

This Privacy Policy ("Policy") is being framed in accordance with the applicable law.

 - 1.1 In this privacy policy (hereinafter the "**Policy**") we explain how we collect, use and protect your personal information.

- Collection of Information: We do not automatically collect or store personally identifiable information from website visitors.

 - 2.2 We do not request sensitive personal data such as passport details, payment information, or device data.

 - 2.4 We may also collect and use voluntary submissions through third-party platforms such as LinkedIn or Twitter, including responses to surveys, feedback, or campaign participation, for internal analysis, engagement, or improving our outreach. Such submissions are optional and governed by the respective platform's privacy terms.
 - 2.5 Our website uses cookies to facilitate analytics, track basic usage metrics and optimize performance. These cookies do not collect personal information unless voluntarily submitted by the user. You may choose to disable cookies via your browser settings; however, this may affect the website's functionality.
- 3. **Use of Information :** Any personal information shared with us (e.g., via newsletter sign-up or contact form) will be used solely to respond to your inquiry, send company updates or newsletters (if subscribed) and improve communication. We do not use your data for profiling or advertising.

- 4. **Information Sharing:** We do not share, sell, or distribute any personal information with third parties, except where legally required. We do not partner with advertising platforms or data brokers, nor do we track user behavior across the web.

 - 4.2 We also may share your information if we believe, in our sole discretion, that such disclosure is necessary:
 - i. To comply with legitimate and enforceable subpoenas, court orders, or other legal process; to establish or exercise our legal rights; to defend against legal claims; or as otherwise required by law. In such cases, we reserve the right to raise or waive any legal objection or right available to us.
 - ii. To investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal or suspected illegal activities; to protect and defend the rights, property, or safety of Company, our customers, or others; and in connection with our Terms of Use and other agreements.
 - iii. In connection with a corporate transaction, such as a divestiture, merger, consolidation, or asset sale, or in the unlikely event of bankruptcy.
- 5. **Protection of Information :** We take reasonable precautions to safeguard any limited data voluntarily submitted through our website.
 - 5.1 However, no data transmission or storage system can be guaranteed to be 100% secure.
